Description:

The Ap Thomas Partnership was employed by the North Wales Fire and Rescue Service to lead a team of consultants to change the old fire station at Rhyl into the first Community Fire Station in Wales. The £1.75 million project involved the refurbishment and upgrading of the operational fire fighting and rescue provisions and the introduction of new communal rooms and facilities within the site. The design allowed for careful segregation of the activities whilst allowing some facilities to be shared.

During the construction phases the fire station was operational and the sequence of building operations and the phasing of the works was a critical aspect of the project. The project was completed successfully and the busy fire station is now also a centre for communal and commercial activities which are accommodated in five new activity rooms, each with multimedia installations.
